Florida announces roles for new staff hires

Florida has officially announced the roles for each of its new staff hires, as well as a promotion and a shift in duties for a returning assistant.

GAINESVILLE, Fla. -- Florida has officially announced all of its new coaching hires and assigned their roles on the staff heading into the 2017 season.

As expected, running backs coach Tim Skipper will shift to the defensive side of the ball to coach linebackers. That move allows the newcomers to slot nicely into positions they're familiar with. Skipper has plenty of experience coaching linebackers but spent his first two seasons on McElwain's staff working with the running backs.

Former West Virginia running backs coach JaJuan Seider will take over the running backs, while Brad Davis will coach the offensive line and Corey Bell will coach the defensive backs.

Defensive coordinator Randy Shannon is also expected to work with the defensive backs now after working with that group during the Outback Bowl as the interim coordinator.

In addition to the new hires, defensive line coach Chris Rumph was promoted to co-defensive coordinator.
